Dear Resident or Owner,

Please be advised that as part of the construction for təməsewitxw Aquatics and Community Centre, the City of New Westminster will be installing new storm and sanitary services on the roads adjacent to the new facility. In order to complete this work, East Sixth Avenue and Glenbrook Drive will be impacted June 29 to August 4, 2023. Construction will take place Monday to Friday starting at 7:00 am until 5:30 pm, and Saturdays from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Phase 1 of construction will commence along Glenbrook Drive between East Sixth Avenue and Eddie Drive starting June 29 for approximately three weeks. This section of road will be closed to traffic and parking 24/7 for the full duration of the **project.** Phase 2 will take place along East Sixth Avenue starting July 12 for approximately three weeks with single-lane alternating traffic between Cumberland Street and McBride Boulevard. There will be no parking along East Sixth Avenue during this time. Please see work zone maps on reverse.

For a portion of this work, the bike lane will be closed and cyclists will be required to share the road with vehicle traffic. Some sidewalk closures will also be required and pedestrians will be directed to use the sidewalk on the opposite side of the street. Traffic control personnel will be on-site during the day to assist the public in navigating the work site.

We will endeavor to minimize disruption as much as possible. However, as with a project of this nature, some disruption is inevitable. If special consideration is required, please contact the project managers listed below.
